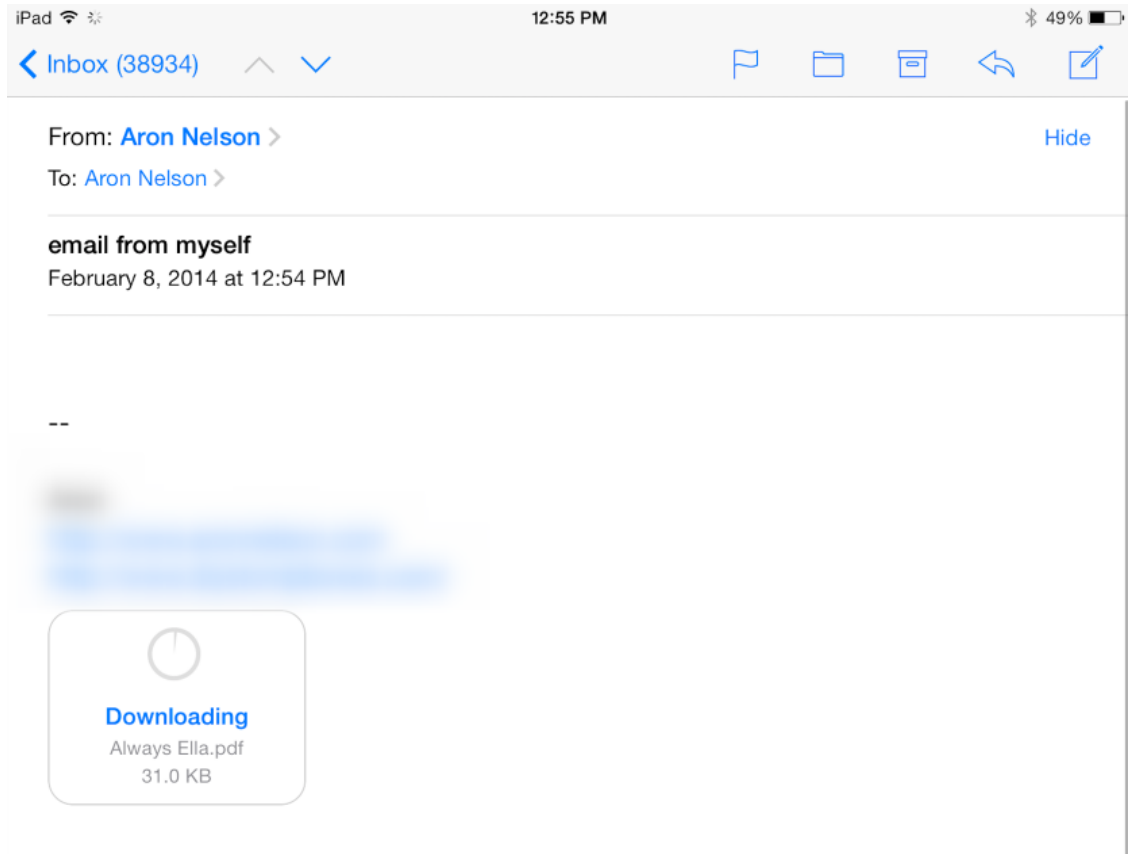


How to import PDF files into unrealBook from emails

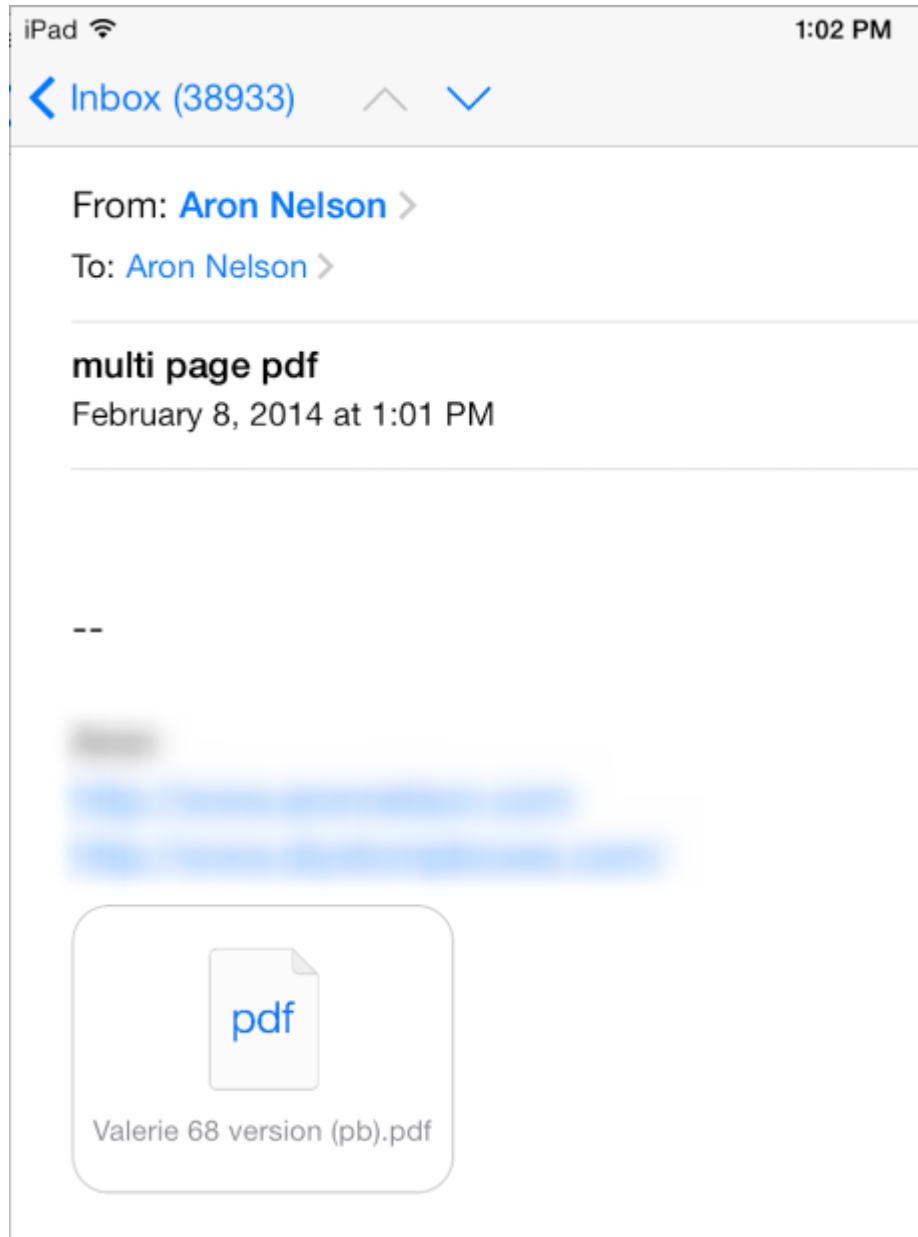
This will show you how to import a PDF that you receive via email

Open the email message in Apple Mail on the iPad



If the PDF is not shown, tap the icon on the bottom to start the download. Note that the file must have .pdf at the end of the name. In this case, the name is Always Ella.pdf

Once the download has finished, you will see an icon or the PDF displaying in the email message.



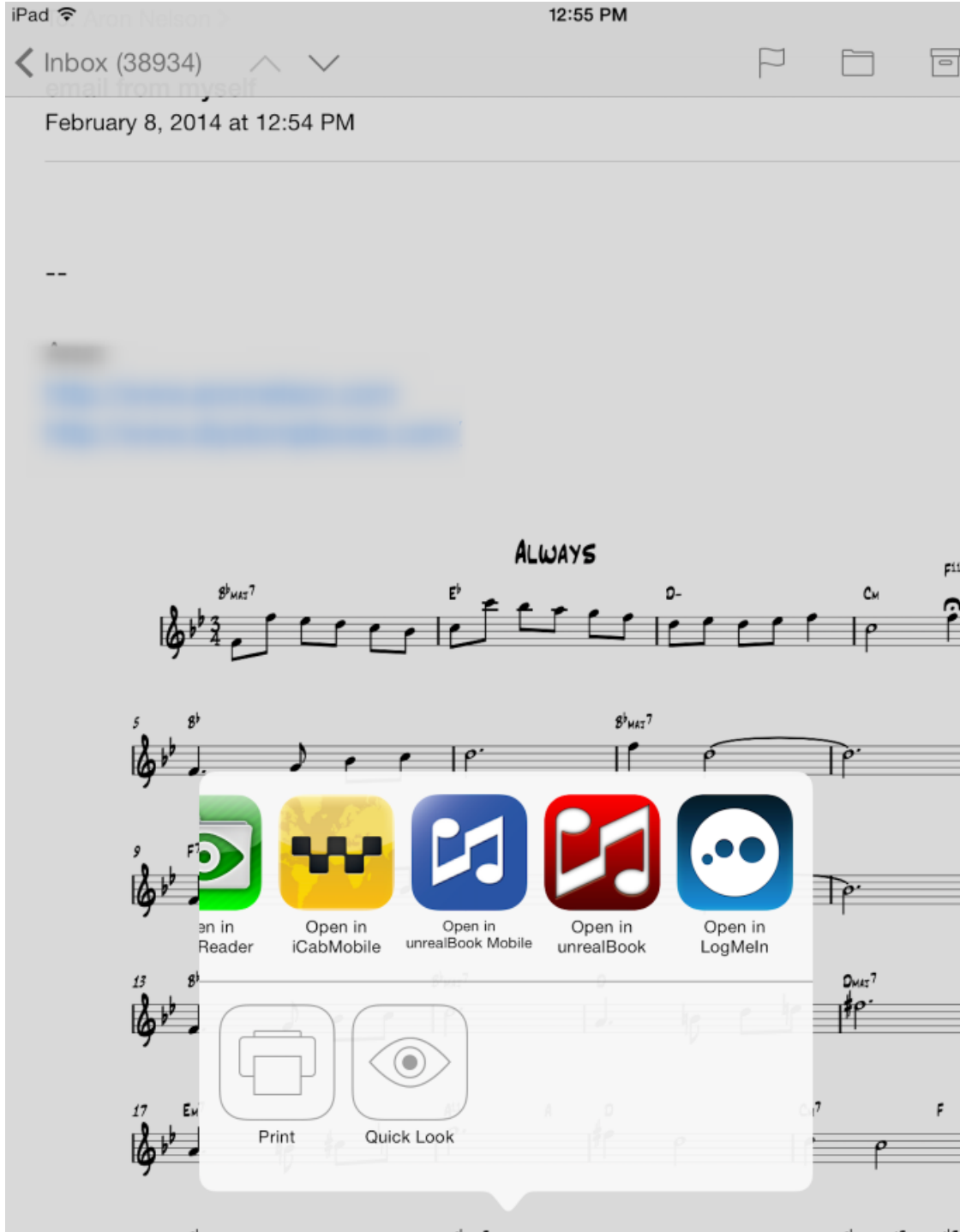
If the PDF is one page, you will see the PDF displayed, otherwise you will see a PDF icon with the name below it. If it is a multi page document, tap the icon and the PDF will be displayed.

For a multi page document, once it is showing, tap the share icon on the top right of the screen and choose **Open in unrealBook**

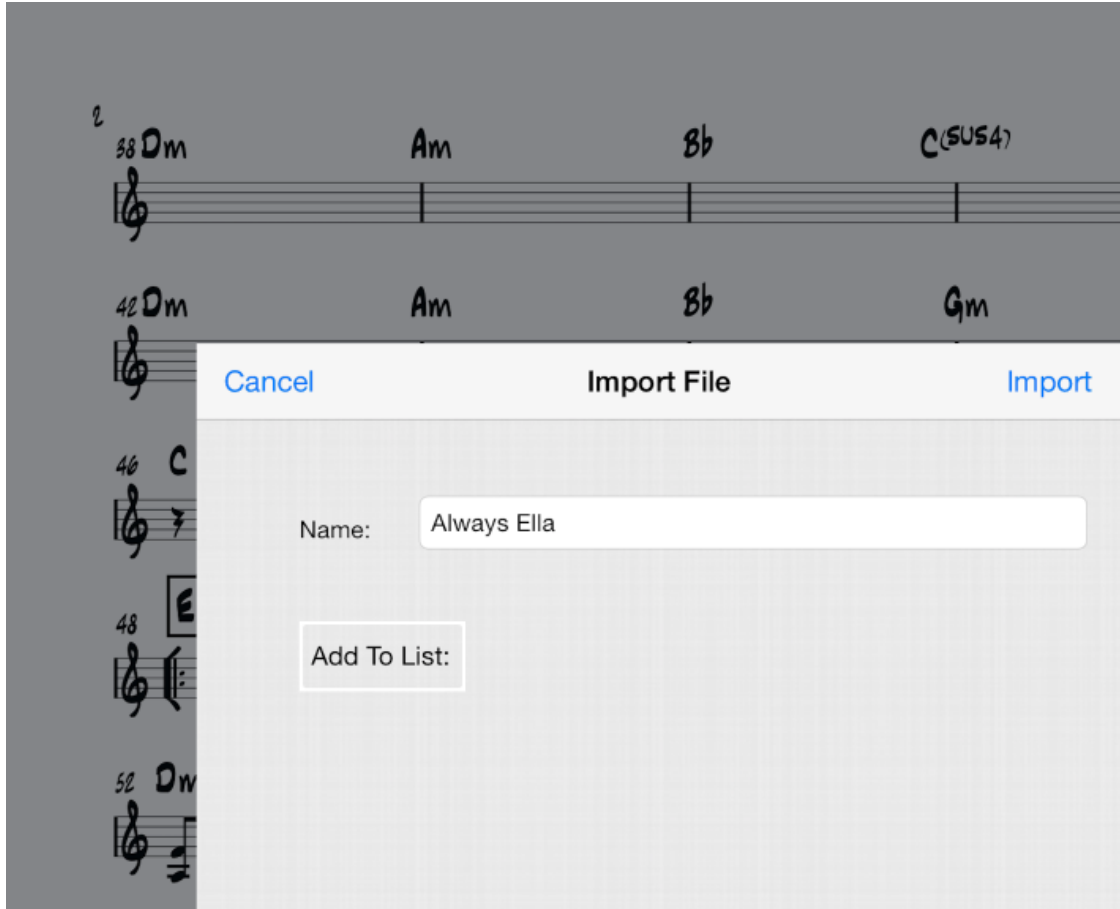


Tap **Open in unrealBook**

For a single page document - the PDF will be displayed. Press and hold on the PDF to show the Open in menu. Choose Open in unrealBook



After you have chosen Open in unrealBook, unrealBook will open and an import dialog will appear. Press Import after naming (if needed)



You can rename the file here - no need to put a .PDF on the end of the name. Just name the file if needed.

The file has been imported. Go to Songs->All Files to choose and view the file
